<b>Pernod Paris Anise 40.0%</b> A Parisian classic, Pernod is a very popular French aniseed liqueur. Pernod is made with coriander, star anise and mint. Best served long with water and ice.	£3.20
<b>Campari 25.0%</b> Made by infusing 68 bitter herbs, plants and fruit in alcohol and water. The result is a rich, complex aperitif that works brilliantly in cocktails such as Negroni, Americano, rich, deep aromas. Slightly herbal. A little bitter with hints of burnt grapefruit. Aromatic, toffee, fruit salad, lush nectarine, custard. Floral, apple blossom, honeysuckle, apple peels, pear, touch of smoke. Palate, malty. Gentle smoke weaves its way through the cereal with a touch of spice. Long, malty, walnut and almond finish.	
<b>Glen Moray Whisky 40.0%</b>	£5.65
Light, fresh. Grist, nutty, floral, dried grass, a lightly fruity. Palate, oak, well balanced walnut and grist. Tangy citrus and spicy fruitcake on the finish.	
<b>Hudson Baby Bourbon Whisky 46.0%</b>	£4.70
Robust vanilla, new oak warmth, popcorn and lingering whiff of sugared almond. Palate, Marzipan and candied ginger. A touch of rye spiciness develops. Chocolate peanuts, buttered corn-on-the-cob and light glaze of honey on the finish.	
<b>Jim Beam Bourbon Whiskey 40.0%</b>	£3.65
Quite sweet with gentle notes of vanilla and cut hay, a touch of fresh corn fields and a little cereal sweetness. Good body with notes of toasty oak, a little spice and pepper with an acetone note.	
<b>Jack Daniels Bourbon Whiskey 40.0%</b>	£3.90
Made up of 80% corn, 12% rye and 8% malt. The spirit is filtered through 10 feet of sugar maple charcoal to produce a mellow, slightly smoky character. Light with plenty of sweetness. There are hints of dry spice and oil nuts, a touch of smoke. Quite smooth and soft with notes of banana milkshake, a mixed nut note and caramel. Sweet with a little cereal sweetness and toasty oak.	
<b>Canadian Club Whiskey 40.0%</b>	£3.55
The nose is of medium-body with notes of barley sugar and aniseed, notes of cut grass and fennel, a hint of straw. The palate is quite sweet and gentle. There are notes of winter spice and dark sugars, a touch of rum. The finish is of medium-sweetness and medium-length.	
<b>Jura Whisky 10 Years 40.0%</b>	£5.45
Honeyed barley and peaches in syrup with light wafts of fragrant wood smoke. Palate, oily and subtly spicy at first, before notes of earthy vanilla pod and chocolate, raisins develops.	
<b>Laphroaig Whisky 10 Years 40.0%</b>	£6.05
Really smoky and iodine rich. There are spices, and liquorice, as well as a big dose of salt. Palate, seaweed-led, with a hint of vanilla ice cream. The oak is big, and muscles its way into the fore as you hold this whisky over your tongue. An upsurge of spices develops (cardamom, black pepper, chilli). The only malt from laphroaig's range that is recommends with water, try it, it opens up the palate massively, providing a dazzling array of additional flavours.	
<b>Lagavulin Whisky 16 Years 40.0%</b>	£7.00
A big, very, very concentrated, and redolent of iodine, sweet spices, good mature sherry and creamy vanilla. Very thick and rich. A massive mouthful of malt and sherry with good fruity sweetness. Big, powerful peat and oak. Finish is long, spicy, figs, dates, peat smoke, vanilla. Stunning.	
<b>Jameson Triple Distilled Whiskey 40.0%</b>	£3.20
A full and floral nose leads with the smooth sweetness of marmalade and fudge before a hint of madeira and a little cut grass emerge. Thick and a good body with notes of orchard fruits, both fresh and cooked with a little vanilla cream. Finish, medium-length with spice and honey.	
<b>Southern Comfort 35.0%</b>	£3.55
Sweet, fruity aromas. Tinned peaches, hints of golden syrup and a touch of marzipan. Palate is sweet and creamy. Hints of soft spice, vanilla and honey.	
<b>Glenmorangie Whisky 10 Years 40.0%</b>	£5.45
Very fruity and thick. Rich notes of lemon, nectarine and apple. Spices. Palate is fresh and balanced, vanilla, boiled sweets, very creamy, tiramisu and toffee.	
<b>Talisker Whisky 10 Years 45.8%</b>	£5.35
A fresh and fragrant nose. Through thick, pungent smoke comes sweet pear and apple peels, with pinches of maritime salt from kippers, seaweed. Gordon's London Dry Gin is made with only the finest botanicals, all carefully distilled to create its distinctively refreshing taste. Bold, juniper led, with zesty notes of citrus and super smooth texture. It's no wonder the world's best-selling gin, is also a multiple gold award winning gin.	
<b>Pinkster Gin 37.5%</b>	£4.60
Pinkster Gin is made with delicious raspberries, which are steeped in the gin, lending it both its pink hue and subtle fruitiness. Rounded fruit, a drying touch of pepper, vanilla and coriander on the palate with a zesty raspberry and grassy hint of water mint finish.

Tanqueray Gin is beloved by bartenders for its rich, citrus-led palate. Cedar, juniper oil with a little zesty citrus zest aroma. Huge juniper with spicy notes of orange and lemon peel and just a hint of aniseed, with a long finish.

Crisp juniper and zesty orange flesh, supported by earthy vanilla and spice.

<b>Cambridge Gin 42.0%</b>	£5.20
A terrific gem of a gin from the Cambridge Distillery, made with Macedonian juniper and a selection of botanicals capturing the essence of all four seasons. Cambridge Dry Gin features blackcurrant leaf, lemon verbena, angelica seed, rose and violet petals, basil and rosemary from the distillery gardens.	
<b>The Botanist Gin 40.0%</b>	£5.35
Big notes of citrus, delicate menthol and flowers everywhere. Palate cool at first. It quickly mellows out, warmth growing with citrus, keeping it fresh throughout, long with a good spice finish.	
<b>Silent Pool Gin 43.0%</b>	£4.85
Violet, lavender and lime leaf bring floral aromatics to the nose, while cardamom and juniper give it a spicy edge. Palate with elderflower, chamomile and a waft of orange blossom. Warming honey sweetness and a spark of black pepper. Vanilla and rich honey note last on the finish.

<b>Bombay Sapphire Gin 40.0%</b>	£3.75
Smooth, light and vibrant, with a bright citrus notes and refreshing mint, with a peppery finish.	
<b>Brockman's Gin 40.0%</b>	£4.85
Fruity nose with hints of cooked fruit, strawberry, damson jam, hints of blossom and almond. Palate nutty and fruity with blueberries, juniper and soft aniseed notes. Short, with liquorice root and herbs finish.

This cracking gin from Adnams is distilled in a beer-stripping column before being put through a handmade copper pot still. It is then purified in a rectifier, resulting a very creamy and rich spirit, although at this point it isn't yet technically a gin. To complete the final stage, it is then infused with six different botanicals including juniper, cardamom pod, sweet orange and hibiscus flowers.	
<b>Hayman's Gin 41.3%</b>	£4.35
Fresh orange and lemon, juniper, coriander spiciness with a hint of fennel.	
<b>Williams GB Gin 40.0%</b>	£3.65
The aroma is fittingly juniper forward with warm spicy notes of cinnamon and nutmeg. The palate is dry and full-bodied with a citrus quality with spice at the back, followed by a large helping of juniper. The finish retains that ever present spiciness but with a refreshing touch of citrus zest and a hint of apple.	
<b>Sipsmith Gin 41.6%</b>	£4.85
Distilled with 10 botanicals carefully selected for an even drier balance. Floral, summer meadow notes, followed by mellow rounded juniper and zesty. Gentle with initial dry juniper joined by growing sweetness, showing lemon tart and orange marmalade, garnished by a wave of fresh lemon zest. Dryness leads, with spicy juniper and a hint of lemon tart emerging.	
<b>Chase Pink Grapefruit &amp; Pomelo Gin 40.0%</b>	£6.60
Fresh tropical fruit notes sit up front, with plenty of enjoyable citrus acidity at its core. Juniper notes act as a spicy foil to the full-bodies sweetness.

## WHITE WINE

- 37 • **2018 Albarino Pouco Como, Quinta da Lixa, Vinho Verde, Portugal** £32.95  
A fantastic display of both the fruit and floral character of the Albarino grape. Notes of peach, lemon and grapefruit with floral tones and a generous, full texture on the palate.
- 38 • **2018 Chablis, Domaine de Vauroux, Burgundy, France** £33.50  
Classic mineral Chablis perfumed with delicious racy fruit on the palate. Very stylish.
- 39 • **2016 Cannonball, Chardonnay, California, USA** £36.00  
Sophisticated nose of lemon curd, peaches, and a hint of pie crust. On the palate, zippy stone fruit and tropical notes, pineapple and soft vanilla bean on the finish.
- 40 • **2017 Russian River Pinot Gris, MacMurray, California, USA** £39.95  
With its rich aromas and flavours of pear, baked apple, dried fig and white peach, the MacMurray Estate pinot gris has an expressive, fruit forward character and a rich mouthfeel that will enhance with age.

## RED WINE

- 41 • **2016 A Descoberta Tinto, Casa de Passarella, Dão, Portugal** £27.50  
Ripe red fruit such as plums, cherries and a peppery note on the nose. The wine is deep purple colour and has a deep full smoky flavour, slightly spicy and rich.
- 42 • **2011 Château la Rivalerie, 1ères Côtes de Blaye, Bordeaux, France** £30.25  
Brilliant dark red colour, with good legs, it evokes aromas of red and black fruits, punctuated by spicy notes. The palate is fruity, with decent juicy soft tannins and a rather long pleasant finish. Good match for beef or lamb dishes.
- 43 • **2016 Cabernet Sauvignon, Chateau Ste. Michelle, Washington State, USA** £31.00  
The palate delivers complexity and structure, with its robust blackcurrant and plum flavours, and soft, silky tannins.
- 44 • **2015 Rioja Reserva Única, Sierra Cantabria, Rioja, Spain** £42.25  
Very special nose oak, vanilla and cinnamon. In the mouth flavours are stunning – spice, liquorice, more creamy oak, dusty soft tannins, ripe cherry and balsamic notes. This will pair well with red meats and full flavoured dishes. Sierra Cantabria is a top class rioja producer. If you haven't tried a decent rioja in a while try this, you get a lot of wine for your money.
- 45 • **2015 Orisse du Casse, St Émilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux, France** £42.25  
An opaque purple colour is accompanied by aromas of blackberries, cassis, smoke, espresso, and new wood. Medium bodied, dense, ripe and moderately structured, this wine displays a purity of merlot rich fruit character, with depth of flavour on the finish that we've come to expect from this estate.
- 46 • **2015 Papale Linea Oro Primitivo di Manduria, Varvaglione, Puglia, Italy** £43.95  
Where does one start with such a gracious wine! Prepare your nose by blowing it, then breathe in slowly. Images will invade your brain, plum jam, roasted earth, creamy summer pudding, it will practically fry your mind! Once in your mouth the liquid is so very smooth, it literally takes over the senses and delivers a complex hit of ground de-lux coffee, stewed mangelwurzel and dozens of fruits all at the same time. The silky texture prevents your acid chamber from erupting, instead your inner core breathes out with a sigh. Incidentally this wine is made especially for the Pope.
